Job Summary

Reporting to the Recreation Assistant Coordinator, this position facilitates sport and recreation programs for citizens ages 6 years and older, assists the Assistant Coordinator in the planning and implementing of regular and special activities throughout the year at the school, youth recreation centre, on the various activity fields in Pelly, the curling and skating rinks, as well as assists with various activities that are carried on outside the community and occasionally outside the Territory. The position assists with the maintenance and care of the various facilities and equipment used in activities. He/she is a member of the Youth Committee which generates recreational ideas for the youth of the community. The Recreation Worker also provides mentoring and coaching to individuals and teams along with being a role model to the youth of the community.
