Responsibilities:

- Participate in Daily Safety Meetings when onsite and comply with all Health,

- Cutting diamond drill core;
- Valid the identification of the drilling boxes and the corresponding footage;
- Mark and cut the drilling core;
- Bagged and prepare samples to be sent to the laboratory;
- Lift and handle drill boxes (22kg);
- Verify that the quality control protocol is respected;
- Inform the geology team of any problems in the sampling protocol;
- Make general maintenance of rock saws, sawmills and core shack;
- · Handling, moving, storing of core boxes;
- Ensure compliance with established standards;
- Any other related tasks.
- Be an effective communicator in English (verbal and written) at all levels, including keeping your cross-shift and other team members always informed
- Participate in site-specific training;
- Comply with company standards, as well as Yukon Territory and Canadian federal standards;
