Job Summary

The Lands Steward position reports to the Director of Lands, Heritage and Resources and operates with considerable independence in providing inspections, analysis, advice, opinion and actions related to natural resources management and development programs to maintain compliance with legislation. This position contributes to and supports the planning, development, and implementation of a board and district based natural resource compliance monitoring and inspection of the SFN Traditional Territory and Settlement Lands that ensures resource development activities are conducted in accordance with applicable legislation, regulations department policies and resource management plans for the SFN and its citizens

The position collaborates with licenses (YTG), regulators and other stake holders by interpreting, describing and reporting back to the supervisor any observations that may be out of compliance in regard to forest stewardship, land development, mineral explorations, mining, environmental protections, oil and gas development. The Lands Steward provides a consistent approach to inspections and investigations to ensure compliance with the wide range of natural resource legislation.
